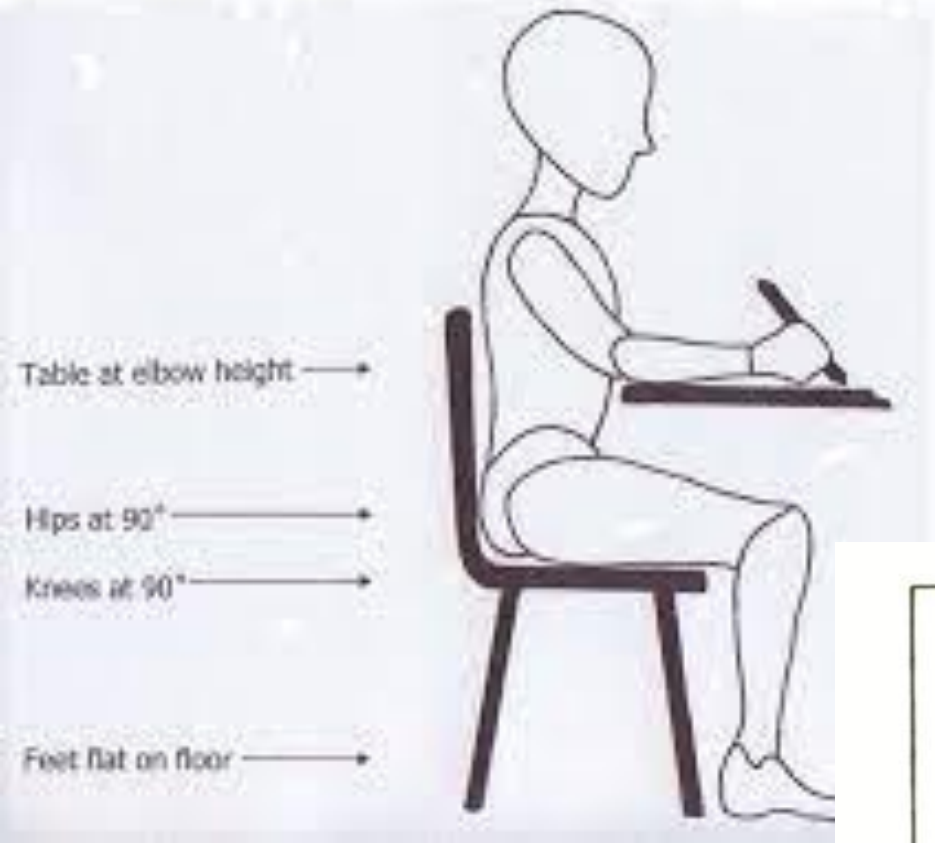


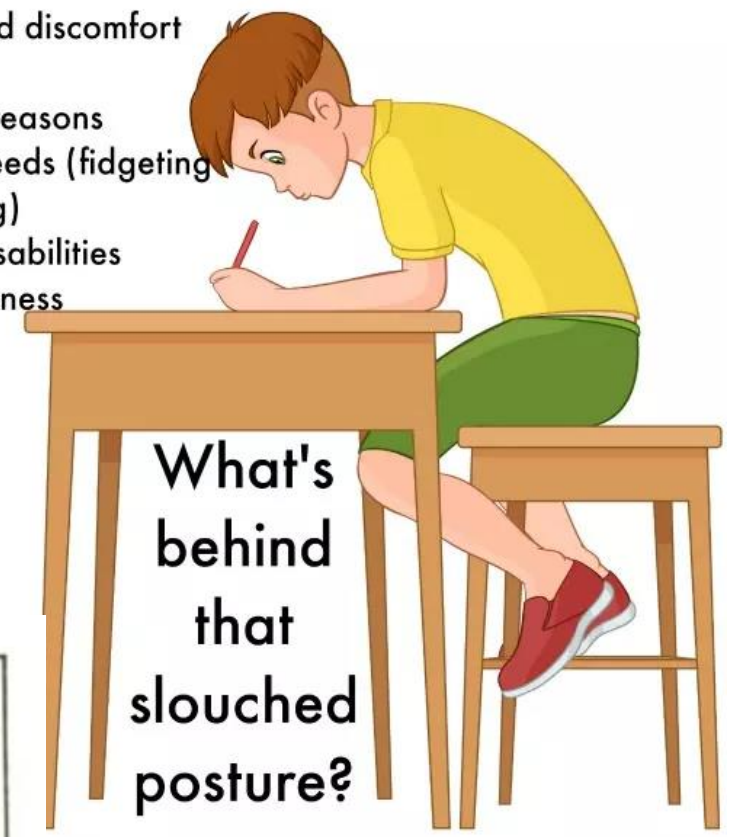
Handwriting

Benefits of cursive writing

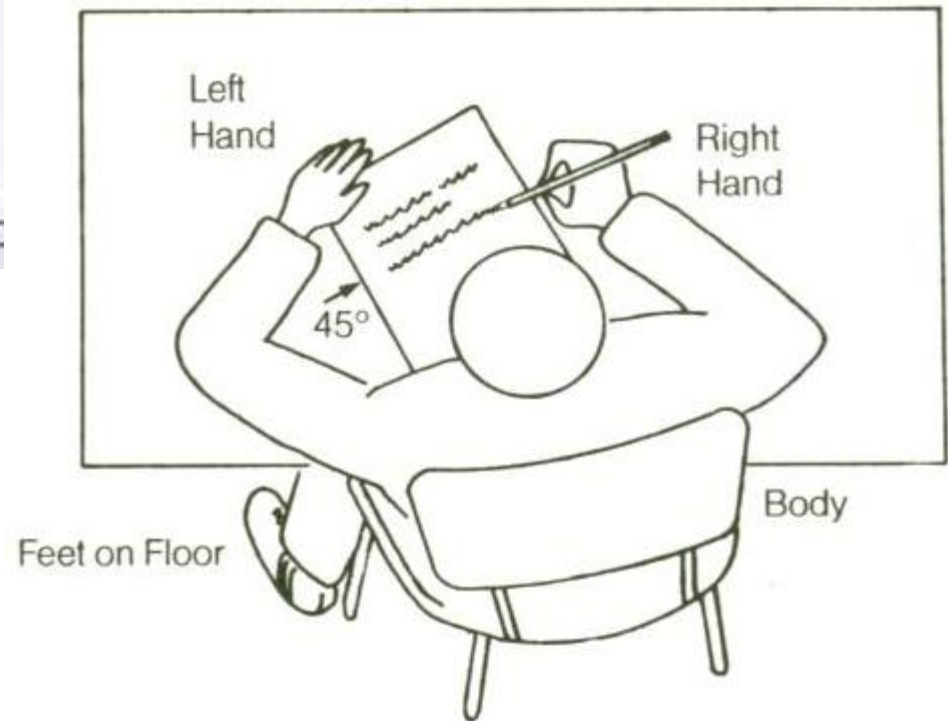
- Improves understanding of word structure - complete words as opposed to separate letters
- Provides a flow of thought as well as a flow of words - helps the writer focus on content as they don't have to slow down with print writing
- Gets the entire brain working – activates different neurological pathways to typing or print writing, particularly in right hemisphere of brain
- Helps you retain more information when taking notes compared to typing notes
- Improves fine motor
- Improves spelling – thinking of words as a single unit, uses muscle memory

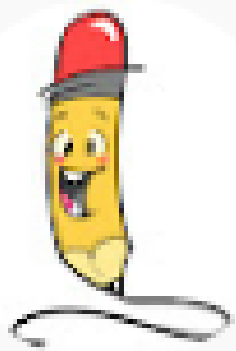
